

WINTER SINGLES AND PAIRS COMPETITIONS

2021-2022

RULES

Refer to Club Competitions & Rules (Oct 2019), Rule 16

Also, please note a few reminders and local amendments.

Singles format will be the first to 21 shots.

Pairs format will be 16 ends, no extra ends to be played in the Group Stages.

Both Singles and Pairs competitors have been drawn into groups, each will play all the opponents in their group once.

Matches should be booked through the on-line booking system.

3 rinks (rinks 4, 5 & 6) may be booked in either the morning (10.00 to 13.00) or afternoon (13.00 to 16.00) slots for these competitions. Competitions should start at the opening times of these slots.

If a player or a pair withdraw during the group stage, all games played by them will be nullified, unless, they have played all their opponents within that group that could be in contention of winning or being a runner(s)-up within the group. In that instance the results will be taken into account.

2 points will be awarded to the winners, 1 point each in the case of a drawn pairs match.

Please ensure that the group letter is named on the score card.

The Score card(s) should be signed and posted in the post-box adjacent to the conservatory entrance.

The cut-off date for the round-robin games will be Sunday, **27 February 2022.**

The usual recommendation stands, better to play the games sooner rather than later due to possible poor weather later in the year, or indeed, any further restrictions that maybe applied.

As the games progress the results will be posted on both the website and on the club notice board.

Provisionally, the Quarter and Semi Finals will be played in **March 2022** with the Finals being played in early **April 2022.**
