## SUMMER COMPETITIONS 2021 RULES

## Reference should be made to the existing 'Lockswood Competition Rules 2018' with the following amendments and/or additions

- All games to be played to our latest COVID 19 Rules and Guidance Information.
- All matches will be played to the number of shots or ends as specified under Competition Rules 2018 or to a maximum of 2hrs. The jack must be in place 5 mins before the 2hr deadline, for the end to count.
   If the match is started late for any reason, the end deadline will be taken as the finish time for respective time slot <u>i.e.</u> 12.00, 14.30, 17.00 or 19.30.
- If the result is a draw, no extra ends should be played and the player/team with highest number of winning ends will be declared the winner. If there is still a draw a count-back will decide on the winner.
- The Bill Hibbard Trophy. If, after 2hr deadline each player has 3 points, the winner will be declared using the winning number of all ends played and, if necessary, a count back over ends played in the final set.
- . Due to time restraints, there should be no trial ends or visiting the head.
- If the jack is improperly delivered it should be placed by the opposing player/team at whatever length they wish, with the mat unchanged.
   In singles it should be placed by the marker according to instructions.
- All matches to be booked online. Please ensure that the name of the marker is included for the singles matches.
- Score cards are to be recorded by the home side (or marker in the case of the singles matches). After acceptance by all parties the card should be posted in the post box located adjacent to the Clubhouse entrance.
   No signatures are required.

NB. The above clauses apply to all rounds up to and including the semifinals. The Finals will be played out to their designated completion.
